# RCP47: Nativity Flannel Figures—Part 2

**Supplies:** Copies of flannel figures and HomeLink, scissors, one-inch strips of felt (three per child), crayons or colored pencils, glue sticks, resealable plastic bags

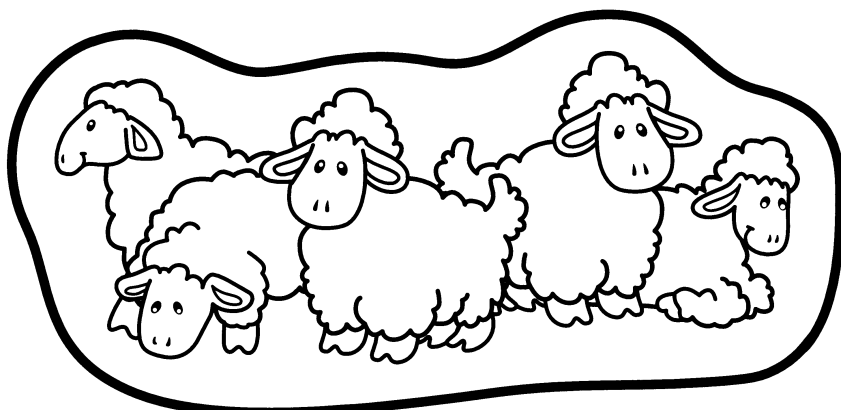
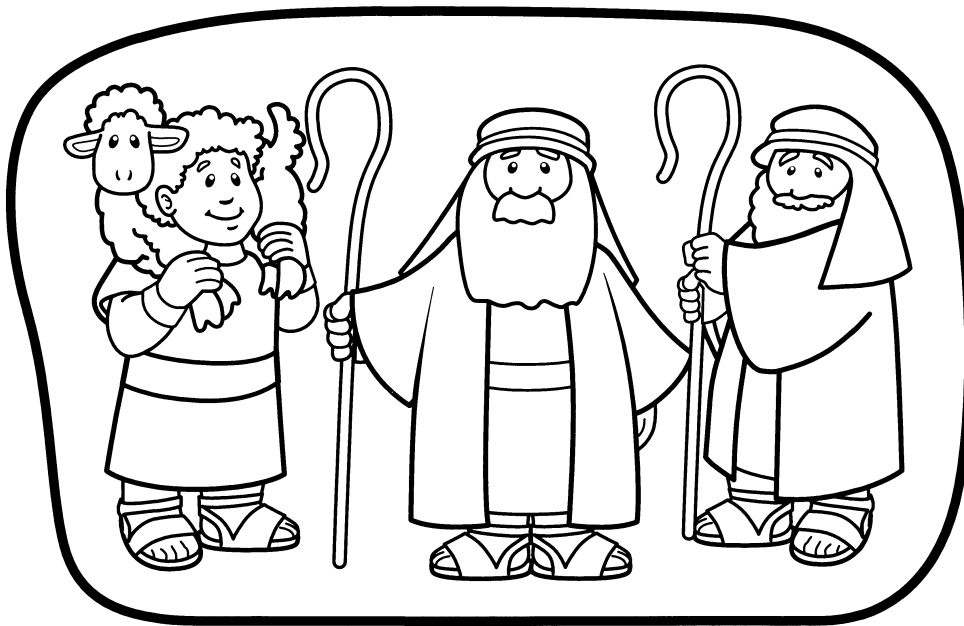
**Preparation:** For each child, make a copy of the Nativity Flannel Figures on this page. Cut out the figures for younger children.

**Directions:** Let the children color the figures of baby Jesus, the shepherds, and the sheep. If not already done, help the children cut out the figures. Have the children glue a strip of felt to the back of each figure. Send home the figures and the HomeLink in a resealable plastic bag, labeled with each child's name.

**HomeLink:** Luke 2:1-20

This is the second week in the series of Nativity Flannel Figures. Help your child use these figures to review the Bible stories. You may want to put a piece of felt in a special place for your child to place the figures on.

**Mary and Joseph traveled to Bethlehem. They had to stay in a stable because the town was so crowded. Baby Jesus was born there. That same night an angel came to some shepherds. "Jesus, God's Son, is born!" the angel said. The shepherds found baby Jesus. They told everyone they saw, "Jesus is born!"**

# RCP48: Nativity Flannel Figures—Part 3

**Supplies:** Copies of flannel figures and HomeLink, scissors, one-inch strips of felt (four per child), glue sticks, crayons or colored pencils, resealable plastic bags

**Preparation:** Make a copy of the Nativity Flannel Figures below for each child. Cut out the figures for younger children.

**Directions:** Let the children color the figures of the toddler Jesus, the star, the wise men, and the camels. If not already done, help the children cut out the figures. Have the children glue a strip of felt to the back of each figure. Send home the figures and the HomeLink in resealable plastic bags, labeled with children's names.

**HomeLink:** Matthew 2:1-12

This is the last week in the series of Nativity Flannel Figures. Help your child use these figures to review the Bible stories. Since the wise men came at least several months after Jesus was born, your child may want to use the figure of Jesus as a toddler in this story.

**Some wise men, who lived very far away, saw a star. They packed their camels and followed the star. The star led them to Jesus. The wise men worshiped Jesus as King!**
