

Fun Games for Home!

Below are two games which you can play at home that will reinforce the theme of the **God's All-Star Champions** VBS program! These games are optimized for kids ages 6-12.

God's Champions

Make a poster from newsprint and title it: God's Champions. Each student will name something that he or she is a champion at — Bible reader. Gymnastics winner. Fast runner. Eating a double-decker ice cream cone without spilling a drop. (Help each student think of things that they may not consider. Anything counts!)

Each child in your class has special qualities. Encourage them to look for ways God has made them special for Him. Be prepared by coming to class with at least one idea for each child if they cannot think of one. This will also let them know that you think they are special.

THINGS YOU'LL NEED...

- Newsprint
- Crayons or colored markers

Share the Good News

Give students a few minutes to write or draw about something great that God did in their lives this past week. (*e.g.: Made Grandma well. Helped me when I felt sad. Gave my Dad a new job. Gave us sunshine for our game.*) Then, students can share their good news with the class. Have them tell how this encouraged their faith or what God may have taught them through it.

Alternative: Do the above activity. However, for a quicker activity, have students just tell their news.
